Patient with a tibial malunion (fracture healed in a bent position) from an open tibia fracture 50 years ago. This led to severe malalignment and subsequent severe knee arthritis. An osteotomy (bone cut) was performed to realign the malunion. Realignment of the leg led to less knee pain delaying the need for a knee replacement.
