Metatarsophalangeal joint fusion

A second toe amputation was performed years earlier because of a severe crossover toe deformity. This caused her bunion to worsen dramatically requiring a fusion. The third hammertoe was also corrected. Note that the bunion was not completely straightened in order to prevent the toes from continuing to drift. Patient was very satisfied with the outcome.
