Revision Lapidus fusion for failed chevron bunionectomy Lapidus fusion tends to be the most ideal procedure for a recurrent bunion assuming the bunion is not arthritic. In that case, a fusion tends to be the best option. This patient also required shortening of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> metatarsal.
